NORTH TO CENTRAL LINK - GREEN LINK

• WALKING TOUR:

Walk in the footsteps of the British Royal Family and the Politicians of today and yesteryear as you journey past many of London's most exciting Royal and Political addresses. Wind from Trafalgar Square amongst the smart addresses of Carlton Gardens before arriving at the majesty of the Mall and St James' Park, ending under the archway of Horse Guards Parade to Whitehall. Imagine the crowds lining the streets for Royal Weddings and the political intrigue hidden from view on Whitehall; your guide will give you a fascinating glimpse into both the history and modern day of British Royalty and Politics.

On days when there is a Changing of the Guard, your guide will walk you directly to Buckingham Palace to see this traditional ceremony for yourself before completing a short tour back to Trafalgar Square.



INFORMATION: The tour is guided in English and departs at 10.30am every day from Trafalgar Square (stop 9 – red route) and will last approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.
