




Volume and value (at constant prices) trends since 1980




Inbound visits by journey purpose since 1978 (000s)




Inbound visits by world region (000s) since 1978




Regional spread of inbound visits since 1999



Heathrow passenger traffic by route segment since 2006 (rolling 12 months)




Accommodation sector bedroom occupancy (England, January 2015 to July 2023)



Top concerns for Europeans most likely to travel in next six months





Cost of passenger transport by air versus overall CPI in Euro area (2015 = 100)




Food commodity price indices adjusted for inflation since 1990 (2014-16 = 100)


Travel behaviours Europeans most likely to adopt before reaching destination




Travel behaviours Europeans most likely to adopt after reaching destination



Europeans' intention to travel within Europe during next six months




Current and projected real GDP growth



Trends in OECD consumer confidence since 1974





Looking ahead to 2024...

- The UK will introduce an Electronic Travel Authorisation scheme for GCC nationals early in 2024, extending to other non-visa visitors later in the year
- The cost of an ETA to enter the UK will be £10
- The cost of a short-term visitor visa is to increase 15% from its current £100
- Meanwhile Brits going to the EU will have to apply for and purchase an European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS) by autumn 2024 at a cost of €7 (free to under 18s and over 70s)
- There are potential displacement opportunities on offer from Paris hosting the Olympic and Paralympic Games and Germany hosting the Men's Euros
- And we can expect a UK general election...




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
Geopolitics

- World Economic Forum suggests that "geopolitical and geoeconomic relations between major economies are set to experience significant volatility over the next six months"
- An era of globalization is transitioning to one of polarization, with a growing tendency for tribalism not just between countries but also within societies
- This is problematic at a time when many would argue a coordinated and collaborative approach is essential in addressing climate change
- A recent StudentUniverse survey found 82% of youth travellers said the laws / politics / attitudes of a country would impact their willingness to visit
- What happens in Ukraine may influence China's stance towards Taiwan


Estimated and projected share of global economy 1980 to 2028

Estimated and projected EU population (millions)




Change in the ethnic mix of the US population between 2010 and 2020


Asian alone or in combination

American Indian and Alaska Native alone or in combination


Black or African American alone or in combination




Share of foreign-born population of Australia by arrival date in Australia

UK Greenhouse Gas Emissions by transport mode: % change 1990 to 2019



A StudentUniverse survey found climate change is a concern but not a blocker, with half saying it had little or no impact on their desire to travel overseas.


Only 23% said they would consider paying a carbon offset.

Technology: more friend than foe (hopefully)


- In recent decades the internet and use of hand-held devices has transformed tourism behaviour before, during and after trips





Have recent decades been a golden age for UK inbound tourism?

- The UK has benefitted from...
- Being on the doorstep of wealthy Europeans with easy access to our shores
- Strong cultural and familial ties with North Americans and Australasians
- One of the world's leading hub airports in our best-known / most visited city
- Rapid expansion in the availability and ease of booking low-cost air travel
- A softening exchange rate helping to improve our value for money narrative
- Global coverage from events such as royal weddings and hosting the Olympic and Paralympic Games
- Being in an expanding EU, thereyby growing our pool of barrier-free visitors and workers

Has that golden age come to an end?

- Future outbound tourism growth will be from markets where we have few if any competitive advantages
- Our traditional source markets are set for slow economic growth, and zero or negative population growth
- Our transport infrastructure needs sustained and significant investment
- Protecting and promoting our cultural and heritage assets needs sustained and significant investment
- The slow march of demography will impact staff recruitment and retention
- Net Zero targets and climate change necessitate difficult conversations about what constitutes good inbound tourism growth in the future

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
